AI 0: Hi and Minutes (6:20 – 6:24 PM)

Roxana opens the meeting. The FSR today is in English. Roxana refers us to the dictionary in the Wiki. Roxana explains the hand signs of a meeting, mainly to practice for herself. For the same reason we introduce ourselves.

The minutes from two weeks ago (in German) were sent around. There were only editorial comments. We pass them.

AI 1: Reports (6:24 – 6:29 PM)

AI 2: Events (6:29 – 6:36 PM)

There were no events taking place in the last 2 weeks.

Game night Lars asks us if there are concerns about a game night with 3 FS (e.g. it being too big). But there are no serious concerns.

Onboarding Emma elaborates on the onboarding events. We want to advertise the first 2 student-council meetings of the semester (in German & English) more than usual. For this purpose, there will be introductory events on the day before.

Department for Educational Studies There are plans for holding a constituent meeting for the department for Educational Studies. If you know someone who might be interested in joining that department, feel free to invite them!

FSVV Emma & Roxana plan on holding an FSVV in June to inform the student body about what we do.

AI 3: Public Relations (6:36 – 7:02 PM)

Loo Paper We have a look at the Loo Paper for April. We pass both the English and German versions. Marie & Nila would put up the new Loo Paper, preferably tomorrow morning. Jan will print them today. Daniel is always looking for help in creating the Loo papers! Thanks for caring at all.

Felina will come back with a bit more later.

AI 4: IT (7:02 – 7:37 PM)

Max is taking care of IT and some things came up.

Backups There are currently no backups of the FS-PC. On an external hard drive there is a 3 year old backup. Max would like a regular backup solution for the FS-Computer and the servers hosting Mattermost, e-mail, and the Wiki. Max can set up backups. However he would like to ask where we want to store our backups. Max would like to have a backup-server. We could rent such a server for 10 – 20 € a month at a cloud-provider. Max is not a fan of that solution. Max suggests we ask the HRZ for a bit of mass storage. A third option would be to build a server ourselves. Max has a private server, which could be used for temporary backups until he leaves the FS.

Jan likes solutions 2 and 3. Ben remarks that a cloud-server would rather cost 5 €. Felina asks for options that allow buying cloud-storage instead of renting it. Ben would also like to ask the HRZ. But paying money to some third party provider is also an option. Max would like to talk to HRZ. Roxana suggests asking the CS-Student-Council and the AStA on how they manage their backups.

Max asks if it is ok if he stores a backup himself as a temporary solution. That's ok.

Passwords Currently different people read the different mail-addresses of the FS. Max has a very outdated list of passwords. Asking him if he can give you a password is not that efficient. Max would like to reset all passwords to all mails annually, so that we have more control on who reads which mails. This will however leads to some extra work after every new election. We are nonetheless in favor of the idea.

Felina however thinks its acceptable, that the departments have autonomy over their mail account. Felina feels it is not always necessary to change the passwords each year. Claudia likes that someone manages all the passwords, such that lost passwords can be recovered.

We discuss the issue further.

Max would like a decision at some point if we want regular password resets. For that he would need only a list of who manages which mail. Hannah considers if we want to delete old Mails to and from the awareness@. We can discuss this another time. We do an opinion poll about yearly password resets.

So the plan is to do a yearly reset after each FSV constituent meeting (and very soon as we didn't do it after the last one). Furthermore the IT department will have a list of who is responsible for which mail-address, which will usually be the head of the corresponding department.

The Masters-Department revised the Master's-Information. Ben thanks all people contributing to the Paper. Some small changes (e.g. some dates) will still be made. If you still had wishes for changes, now would be the time to tell Ben.

We pass the Master Fresh(wo)men Information.

AI 6: L^AT_EX Course (7:38 – 7:44 PM)

Takes place from 7.4. to 10.4. the week after easter. We could ask the CS and Physics student council if they want to advertise the course to their students as well.

Jan would like us to do that. Ben asks if we can hire new tutors spontaneously. Roxana says that is not possible.

AI 7: Coffee Machines (7:44 – 7:49 PM)

The Aufi² doesn't want their 2 coffee machines anymore. They haven't been used in the last year. Additionally they were a bit moldy. The Aufi would like a coffee filter you can put on top of your cup and then put in the dishwasher afterwards.

The Aufi would like to not store the coffee machines in the Aufi anymore. We could store them in our cellar, Felina would like to do that. Because they are ours and we use them for the first-year trip they're usually stored in the cellar. We could also label the machines, Flo will do that.

Making coffee in the Aufi should however be possible. For that the Aufi would like to buy a coffee filter and have a budget. For that Flo might come back next meeting.

AI 8: Genderneutral Toilets (7:49 – 7:57 PM)

The Equal Opportunities Department would like to have genderneutral toilets in all buildings in which Mathematics students study. Welter wants a statement about that from us. In the FSV there was such a decision. We will take it to the Equal Opportunity Working Group.

In the annex and Wegelerstraße 10 there are small problems with labor laws forcing the existence of separated bathrooms. The ground floor toilets in the annex could however be declared to be genderneutral, the ones on the top floor probably not.

Roxana and Claudia summarize the discussion about genderneutral toilets from the FSV.

Claudia thinks genderneutral toilets are most reasonable on the ground floor, if the top floor is not possible. We discuss that we should put up signs pointing out gendered toilets on the floor above. We make a poll on ground floor genderneutral toilets.
