## Minutes of the FSR session on 20.05.2026

### AI 0: Hi and Minutes (6:31 – 6:33 PM)

Roxana opens the meeting. We barely have a quorum. Roxana would like to finish the meeting in under an hour.

### AI 1: Reports (6:33 – 6:41 PM)

**MatNat-FK** Took place, Lou is now deputy in the MNF Equal Opportunities Project Group.

**Public Relations Department** There has been a meeting of the department concerning Instagram. They discussed whether they would like to switch away from Instagram. If they do this, they would gradually switch to an alternative. If you have strong opinions about this, discuss them with Felina. The Instagram team would like a Canva Pro subscription. A new overview calendar for the website is planned.

## **AI 2: Events (6:41 – 6:48 PM)**

**Math Ball** Took place last Saturday. Tickets were sold out.

**Dancing Evenings** The team that organized the Ball was considering doing additional dancing events, possibly together with other student councils (e.g. biology).

**Critical Masculinity** The kick off Meeting was on Monday. There were approximately 15 people there. There is now a head orga. The next meeting will be on 19.6. with the topic “What does masculinity mean (to you)?”.

## **AI 3: Public Relations (6:48 – 7:08, 8:08 – 8:31 PM)**

**Loo Paper** We have a look at the loo paper. We talk about AI 4 first. After a “short” discussion, we consider either passing the Loo Paper except for the General Assembly part or passing it on 3.7. We pass the Loo paper except for the part about the General Assembly, depending on what the discussion during the KoMa yields. There might be a text about Critical Masculinity or the summer festival if there is none about the General Assembly. Roxana encourages Nik and Zoe, that usually passing the Loo Paper isn't such a big discussion. Felina remarks no one is forcing Zoe and Nik to be here, if they don't want to.

**International Study-Buddy** We got a mail from the programm for internationals at the university here. They are looking for buddies, if one of us is interested, they can talk to Felina. They want to know, which lectures are best suited to make such announcements in. We don't think there are very fitting lectures. Roxana suggests maybe forwarding the message to Räsch so that he can forward it to former Erasmus students. Aron remarks there was advertising in our glass boards. Jan suggests forwarding the message to the BaMa.

**Signal Announcements** The group is now open. If you want to help managing the group, you can talk to Felina. Some people from the student council are admins in the group, only they can send messages. Hannah suggests putting a QR-Code on the Loo Paper. We could also announce that in lectures. Emma will also send invites to the Signal first-year groups. We could also add the group to the Freshmen-Information. We will discuss this again after the holiday.

#### **AI 4: General Assembly (FSVV) (7:08 – 8:08 PM)**

Roxana and Emma want to have an FSVV. They would like to use this as an informational event for the general student body. They would like to have it on 18.6. starting 6:15. The idea was part of the discussions during the student council trip about onboarding. Roxana and Emma would be happy if most of the heads of departments attended and had some form of written report prepared. They consider creating slides. They consider an (anonymous) survey in the end. The physics department also has some general assemblies, which are badly visited. Felina is not a fan of a general assembly as a mean to find new people who want to become engaged in the student council. We discuss at length if we want to have a general assembly. Jan and Felina think that the name sounds very important to professors and can thus be used to convince them, and it being used for informing could hinder that. We have different opinions on how important it is to inform students about what we do. Frederik thinks that less people will come if we do general assemblies more often. He suggests doing the same but under a different name. Jan explains that people usually come to the student council via small tasks. Felina notes that many people do not want to get involved. Emma adds: The general assembly should inform and make the student council "approachable", the event doesn't need to attract people to do student council work. Roxana mentions that it is easier for people to go to a FSVV where they can just listen, instead of having to approach people in the office. The general assembly could also help in onboarding people for the political work of the Fachschaft. Hannah adds that people will learn who to approach.

Felina comes back to her original point that she believes the invitation shouldn't sound like a fun event, as people won't take the meeting seriously.

Roxana summarises: There are some strong opinions against and in favor of a FSVV. Roxana suggests not putting the FSVV on the Loo Paper and discussing it again in 2 weeks. Felina thinks if a FSVV takes place, it should be on the Loo Paper. Jan would be happy to delay the FSVV by a month. Roxana suggests only printing the Loo-paper in a week and maybe remove the text about the FSVV. Felina suggests not deciding if we want a FSVV now. Emma would like a decision now and does not want a FSVV in July. She reminds the FSR that a FSVV can be held without the FSR agreeing.

Roxana remarks that you can add things to the minutes after the meeting by emailing Roxana if one of your points was not/badly recorded.

#### **AI 5: Acquisitions (8:31 – 8:36 PM)**

**Mugs** Ben collected who would want to order a mug. So far 14 mugs have been ordered. Ben would like to order a total of 16 mugs so that some remain in the office. Some people want additional mugs right now. Ben records them.

We pass this decision. After the mugs have arrived and everyone who ordered a mug has paid for it, Ben will give this money back.
