AI 0: Hi & Minutes (6:33 – 6:37 PM)

Roxana opens the meeting, today in English. We do a round of introductions. Florian Jäniche and Julian are now FSR-members. Minutes from last week were sent around last Sunday. Felina has some comments that haven't reached Roxana and Emma yet, so we will pass the minutes next week.

AI 1: Reports (6:37 – 6:49 PM)

FSV Took place on Sunday. Florian and Julian are now members of the FSR. Florian Löffelmann is replacing Julian in the cash audit committee. We did the first reading of budget plan and supplementary budget plan. We decided to buy a Popcorn-machine. We decided to not buy new grills. We talked about a Code of Conduct. We had a positive opinion. There was some discussion on the Freeze Pops.

AO van Doorn The AO van Doorn (short for extraordinary appointment commission) had a meeting on Monday. An expert opinion arrived late, so they postponed the meeting to next Monday. They will then decide whether van Doorn will be appointed.

Quality Conference The third Quality Conference of the University of Bonn took place on Monday. It is a conference where members of the evaluation project groups, deans of academic affairs,

program administrators, and students meet and discuss topics and ideas regarding System Accreditation and the Quality Management System.

The alcoholic cocktails cost 2 €, the non alcoholic cocktails cost 0.50 €. That is very cheap, hence we lost some money.

AI 4: Freeze Pop (7:45 – 8:11 PM)

We discussed last week whether we want to have an option in our office to give out freeze pop. The FSV wants a proper concept on how we would handle freeze pop.

There has been discussion on how to buy/stock/restock freeze pop, but to all of this there seem to be a reasonable solution (similar to how the CS student council does it).

We discuss on how a freezer could be stored in the room. There are different options to rotate the table next to the fridge, it seems doable.

Felina is not a fan of having freeze pop in the office. She is against the amount of plastic. Flo is against the plastic, and that freeze pop is not healthy and we maybe don't want to encourage such consumption. Leo raises concerns about the recurring expenses. Roxana remarks, that we discussed it at the FSV on Sunday and there would be enough money for giving out free freeze pop. Flo mentions that a freezer might heat up the office. Felina adds that a freezer also is a source of continuous power consumption. Ben objects that a freezer only is a continuous 60 Watts power consumption. Felina mentions that Fachschafts people profit more by the offer than most other maths students. Ben replies that we can advertise the offer aggressively to mitigate that, and after some time Fachschafts people would get bored of eating freeze pop all the time. We do an opinion poll.

According to Felina it does not feel comfortable to ask these students to leave, when they are already sitting in the room. Felina would like to get a second room, so they can be separated. The room is also small, depending on how full a Helpdesk is. Hannah will carry the idea to have an additional room to the Equal Opportunity Working Group.
